SUPPORT ST. VINCENT DEPAUL SOC.

Dear Members and Friends of St. Mary's, St. Patrick's and St. Peter's Cathedral:

Ordinary Time begins the day after Pentecost, but the first two Sundays of Ordinary Time are festivals celebrated in white vestments. Last week was Trinity Sunday, and this week is Corpus Christi, The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, transferred from its earlier spot on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. It was celebrated on a Thursday as a reminder of the institution of the Sacrament on Holy Thursday, and in fact the Holy Thursday procession to the altar of repose is actually modeled on the Corpus Christi procession that may be celebrated on this day.

Last Sunday's celebration pointed us toward the heart of the mystery of God himself—that he is an eternal community of life and love within himself. Today's great feast reminds us that the divine life and love are available to us in the Eucharist, the Body and Blood, soul and divinity of Christ himself.

God does not remain in splendid, eternal isolation. His love is boundless and so he has made room for time and for creatures. He has shared his being with us in creation, and he shares his life and forgiveness with us in the wonder of the Eucharistic feast. When we participate in this sacrificial banquet, we are united with the very sacrifice of Christ himself and thus brought into the life of the Holy Trinity.

Salvation is not a matter of walking about on clouds. It is eternal immersion into the wonder and mystery of God. That immersion begins in the sacramental life of the Church, in the Word of God and in prayer. It occurs in the life of the Church, in the spreading of the Gospel, in works of charity, and in the witness of the saints. When we receive the Body and Blood of Christ we are tied into that whole movement toward final salvation.

The greatness of the Sacrament should always challenge us to move beyond lukewarmness and mediocrity. The greatness of the Sacrament should move us constantly to strive to know and practice our faith with the sense of wonder that this great gift should bestow.
